Lorry parking spaces shall be a minimum of 18 metres by 5 metres.

5. Parking for People with Disabilities

In accordance with the requirements of Transport Proposal 16 and Recreation Proposal 1, adequate provision should be made both in terms of the type and position of parking spaces for people with disabilities. Any parking provision should be made within 50 metres of the destination. Spaces should be 3.6 metres wide or have a transfer area of 1.2 metres to one side of a standard size space. 3.2 metres wide spaces may be acceptable where space is limited. Parking spaces should be clearly marked with the British Standard “Disabled” symbol in accordance with BS3262 Part 1 and any parking fee concessions should be stated clearly at the parking space.

6. Access Requirements for Dwellings

- (a) No more than five dwellings may be built off a private drive.
- (b) No more than 150 dwellings may be built off a single access.
