#### **Proposals Matters**

- Proposed Title:** Core Strategy Preferred Options Development Plan Document (DPD): Regulation 25 Further Consultation Document.
- Proposed Subject Matter:** The Core Strategy DPD is a strategic document setting out the vision, objectives and spatial planning strategy for the Borough with policies to facilitate sustainable delivery. It identifies the amount of major new development proposed in the Borough up to 2026 and includes a key diagram and Retail Hierarchy. The Preferred Options version of the document outlines the preferred approach that has been established following consultation with the local community and key stakeholders.
- Proposed Area:** The Core Strategy Preferred Options will relate to the whole of the Borough of Oadby and Wigston.
- Consultation Period:** The 8 week consultation period commences on the 28 November 2008 and runs until 23 January 2009.
