

NOTICE OF ELECTION

ELECTION OF A MEMBER OF PARLIAMENT FOR THE HARBOROUGH CONSTITUENCY

1. An election is to be held of a Member to serve in Parliament for the Harborough Constituency.
2. Forms of nomination paper may be obtained from the Acting Returning Officer, Room 114, Council Offices, Station Road, Wigston, LE18 2DR, who will at the request of any elector for the said electoral area, prepare for signature a nomination paper.
3. Nomination papers must be delivered in person between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. by the candidate, the candidate's agent, the proposer or seconder on any day after the date of this notice, but not later than Tuesday 20 April 2010, to the Acting Returning Officer, Room 114, Council Offices, Station Road, Wigston, LE18 2DR.
4. Acceptable forms of payment of the deposit are by Bankers' Draft (made payable to 'Oadby and Wigston Borough Council Election Fund') or legal tender (£1 coins or coins and notes of greater denomination).
5. If the election is contested, the poll will take place on Thursday, 6 May 2010.
6. New applications to vote by post and requests to cancel or change an existing postal or proxy vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Council Offices, Station Road, Wigston, LE18 2DR, by 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday 20 April 2010 if they are to be effective for this election.
7. New applications to vote by proxy except on the grounds of medical emergency must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Council Offices, Station Road, Wigston, LE18 2DR, by 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, 27 April 2010.
8. New applications to vote by proxy at this election applied for on the grounds of a medical emergency, where the emergency occurred after 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, 27 April, must reach the Electoral Registration Officer, Council Offices, Station Road, Wigston, LE18 2DR, by 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, 6 May 2010 if they are to be effective for this election.
