Statement of Community Involvement (SCI)

Subject Matter

The Statement of Community Involvement sets out the standards to be achieved by the Borough Council in involving the community in the preparation, alteration and continuing review of all Local Development Documents and Planning Applications. The Statement of Community Involvement must meet minimum consultation requirements set out in the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 and related guidance.

Area

The Statement of Community Involvement relates to the whole Borough of Oadby and Wigston.
