

Finance

Oadby and Wigston Borough Council process the information of local finance. This includes the management of government money and providing funding to individuals and business. The process of the finance section and the information that is required is determined by HMRC (VAT and CIS Regulations), Financial Regulations, and Audits. This information is received at point of payment or application. Finance is generally split into sales ledger, purchase ledger and income management.

The retention of the data that is provided to the Finance section will be determined by Oadby and Wigston Borough Council's retention policy. A copy of the retention schedule is available on the Council's website.

The information and personal data that you provide to finance will be processed by Oadby and Wigston Council, which is the 'data controller' for the purposes of the Data Protection Act.
