

The Borough of Oadby and Wigston Local Plan – Adoption Statement 24th April 2019

This Adoption Statement has been prepared in accordance with Regulation 26 and Regulation 35 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2017.

Notice is hereby given that Oadby and Wigston Borough Council resolved to adopt the new Local Plan Development Plan Document (Plan) at its Full Council meeting on Tuesday 16th April 2019.

The Plan is the Council's principal planning policy document and sets out the Vision, Spatial Objectives, Spatial Strategy and Planning Policies for development for the entire Borough area, for the period up to 2031. The Plan replaces the Council's Saved Local Plan, Town Centres Area Action Plan and Core Strategy.

The Plan was considered at an Examination in Public by an Independent Planning Inspector appointed by the Planning Inspectorate. The Inspector's Report was issued on the 25th March 2019. The Report concluded that subject to Main Modifications the new Local Plan was Sound and Legally Compliant, and therefore can be adopted by the Council. The Main Modifications were accepted by the Council and are included in the adopted Plan.

Any person aggrieved by the Borough of Oadby and Wigston Local Plan may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning & Compulsory Purchase Act 2004, on the grounds that (a) the document is not within the appropriate power, and / or (b) a procedural requirement has not been complied with. Any application must be made within 6 weeks from the date of this advertisement.
