Oadby and Wigston Borough Council Local Plan Examination Main Modifications

The Borough of Oadby and Wigston Local Plan was submitted to the Secretary of State for Examination in January 2018. Following the Examination in Public Hearing sessions that took place between April and June 2018 the appointed Planning Inspector, Claire Sherratt DIP URP MRTPI, has requested that the Council undertake a public consultation on Proposed Main Modifications required to make the Borough of Oadby and Wigston Local Plan sound.

The Schedule of Main Modifications has been prepared by the Council following the Hearing sessions. Any final conclusions on soundness and legal compliance will be provided in the Inspector's Report which she will produce after the Proposed Main Modifications consultation has been completed. In reaching her conclusions, the Inspector will take into account any representations made in response to the consultation. Consequently, views expressed during the hearing sessions about soundness and potential Main Modifications which may be necessary to achieve a sound Plan could alter following the consultation process.

The Proposed Schedule of Main Modifications, on which representations are now invited, set out changes to the submitted Borough of Oadby and Wigston Local Plan that are necessary to make the Plan sound and legally compliant. These generally take the form of amendments, deletions and / or insertions to policies and supporting text.

A Sustainability Appraisal of the Proposed Schedule of Main Modifications and a revised Habitat Regulations Assessment (HRA) have also been prepared and published as part of this consultation.

The Council is also consulting on additional Modifications to the Proposed Adopted Policies Map. The modifications to the Proposed Adopted Policies Map reflect, where relevant, the Proposed Schedule of Main Modifications.

The consultation is to run for a 6 week period from Midday Friday, 21 September 2018 until Midday Friday, 2 November 2018.

Please note – the consultation is limited to the Proposed Schedule of Main Modifications and the other documents listed above only and this is not an opportunity to comment on other aspects of the submitted Local Plan.
