



## **Notice of Interim Review Of Polling Districts, Polling Places and Polling Stations (2023)**

Notice is hereby given that Oadby and Wigston Borough Council is undertaking an interim review of the polling districts, polling places and polling stations within its administrative area ahead of the Local Elections scheduled on 4 May 2023.

The Returning Officer will comment on the existing polling arrangements within the Borough and any proposed changes to those arrangements. Electors within the Borough, or within a UK Parliamentary constituency which has any part in the Borough, may make representations.

The Council welcomes the views of all residents, particularly disabled residents, on the Council's proposals, the Returning Officer's comments or any other related matters.

The Council particularly welcomes any person or organisation with expertise in access for persons with any type of disability to make representations or to comment on the Council's proposals, the Returning Officer's comments or any other related matters.

Persons or organisations making representations should, if possible, give alternative places that may be used as polling places and polling stations.

This review will run from 9 January 2023 to 10 February 2023 (inclusive).
