



The Borough of Oadby and Wigston (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2021

NOTICE OF MAKING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN under regulation 17 of the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 that Oadby and Wigston Borough Council has made an Order under its powers contained in sections 32 and 35(1) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) ("the Act") the effect of which in summary will be:

1. To revoke the Borough of Oadby and Wigston (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2015 and replace it with the Borough of Oadby and Wigston Borough (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2021;
2. To vary the charges at the following town centre car parks as follows:

Up to 2 hours	£1.00
Up to 4 hours	£3.00
Over 4 hours (long stay car parks only)*	£4.00

Oadby	Wigston	South Wigston
*Sandhurst Street Car Park East Street Car Park Ellis Park Car Park	*Aylestone Lane Car Park *Paddock Street Car Park Junction Road Car Park Frederick Street Car Park Spring Lane Car Park	*Countesthorpe Road Car Park *Kirkdale Road Car Park *Station Street Car Park

3. To introduce charges at the following leisure site car parks as follows:

Up to 4 hours	£1.00
Over 4 hours	£2.00

Oadby	Wigston
Parklands Leisure Centre Car Park Brocks Hill Country Park Car Park	Wigston Pool Car Park

4. To extend the charged hours of car park enforcement to include Sundays and Public Holidays.
5. To make available for purchase various 12-month and 6-month parking permits for use at all or some of the town centre and/or leisure site car parks, the price for such permits ranging between £10.00 and £75.00 for residents of the Borough and £10.00 and £150.00 for non-residents of the Borough.
6. To make new specific provisions for the introduction, use and enforcement of a physical and virtual parking permit scheme, for the modernisation of payment methods in pay and display car parks, including payment by phone, and for the parking and charging of electric and hybrid vehicles.
7. To make changes in the text to further clarify conditions of use and prevent misuse of the car parks.

The Order will come into effect on 1 December 2021.

If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order is made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.

The Order may be examined at the Council Offices, Station Road, Wigston, Leicestershire, LE18 2DR between the hours of 9.00 am and 5.00 pm Monday to Friday. The Order may also be accessed online on the Council's website at www.oadby-wigston.gov.uk.
