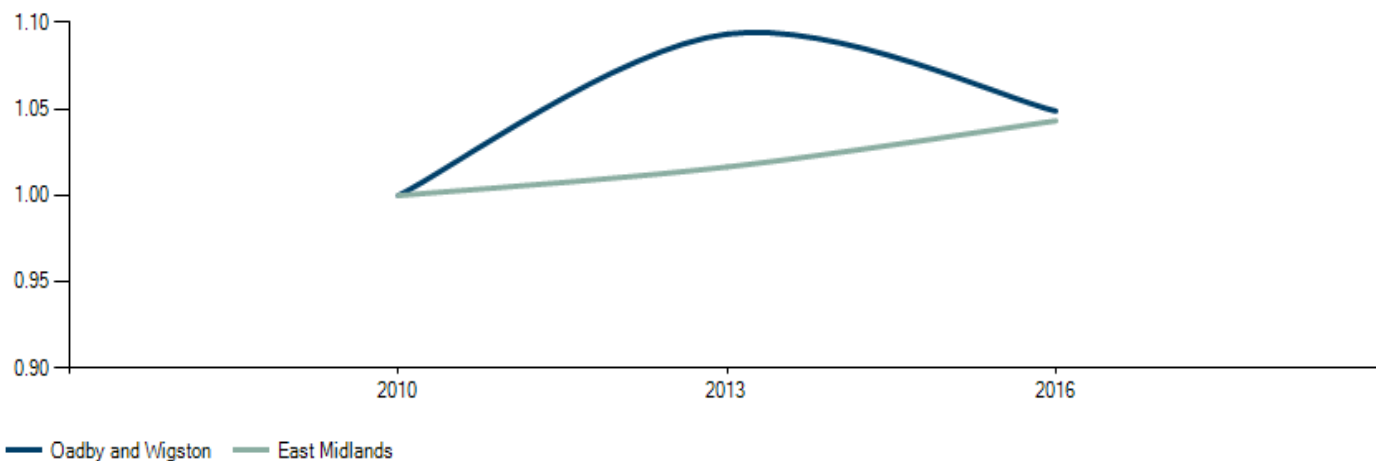

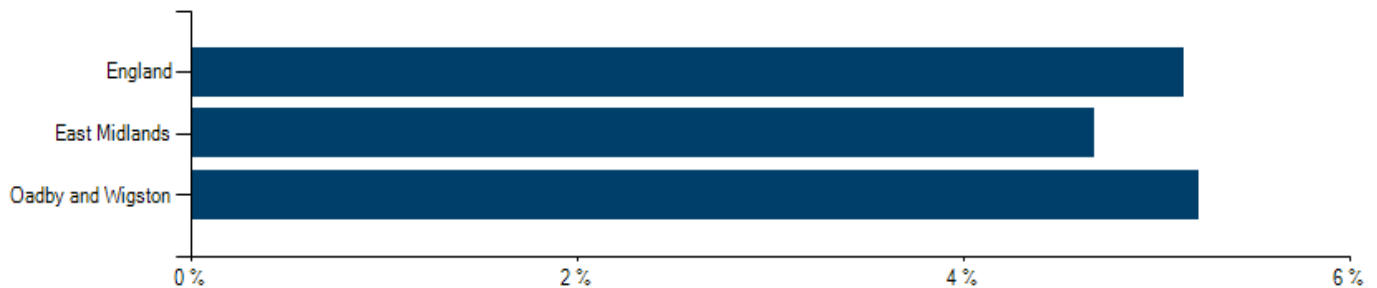

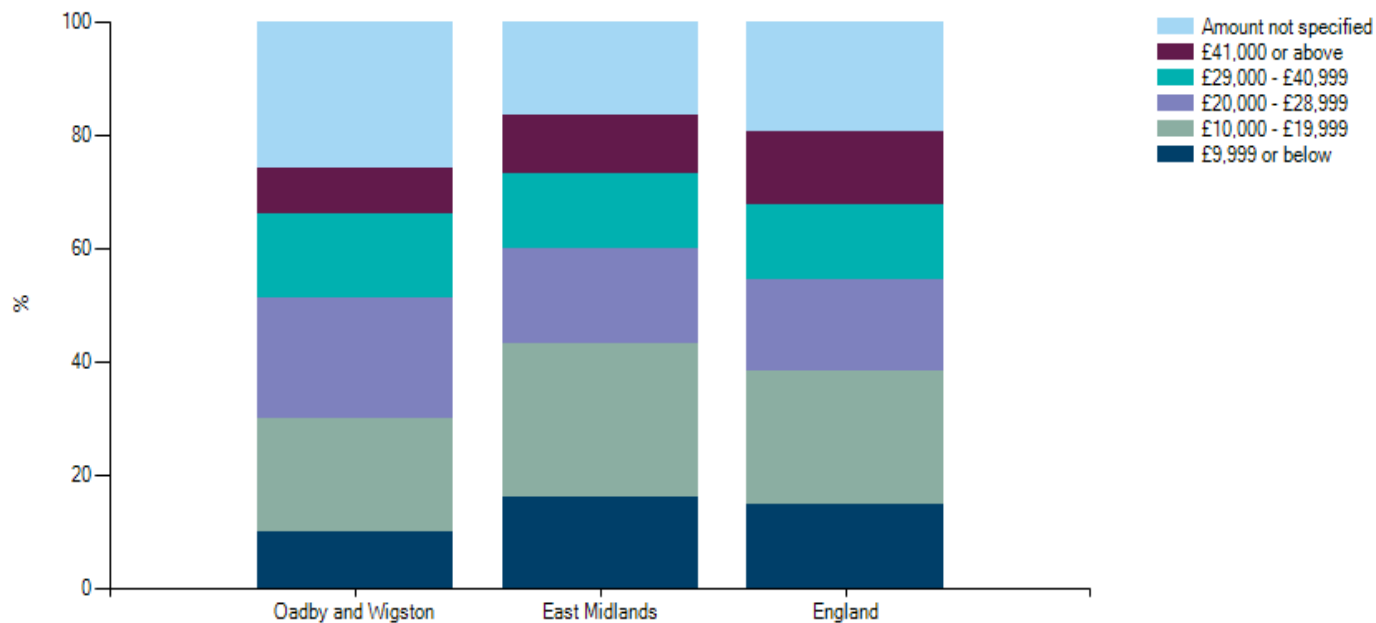

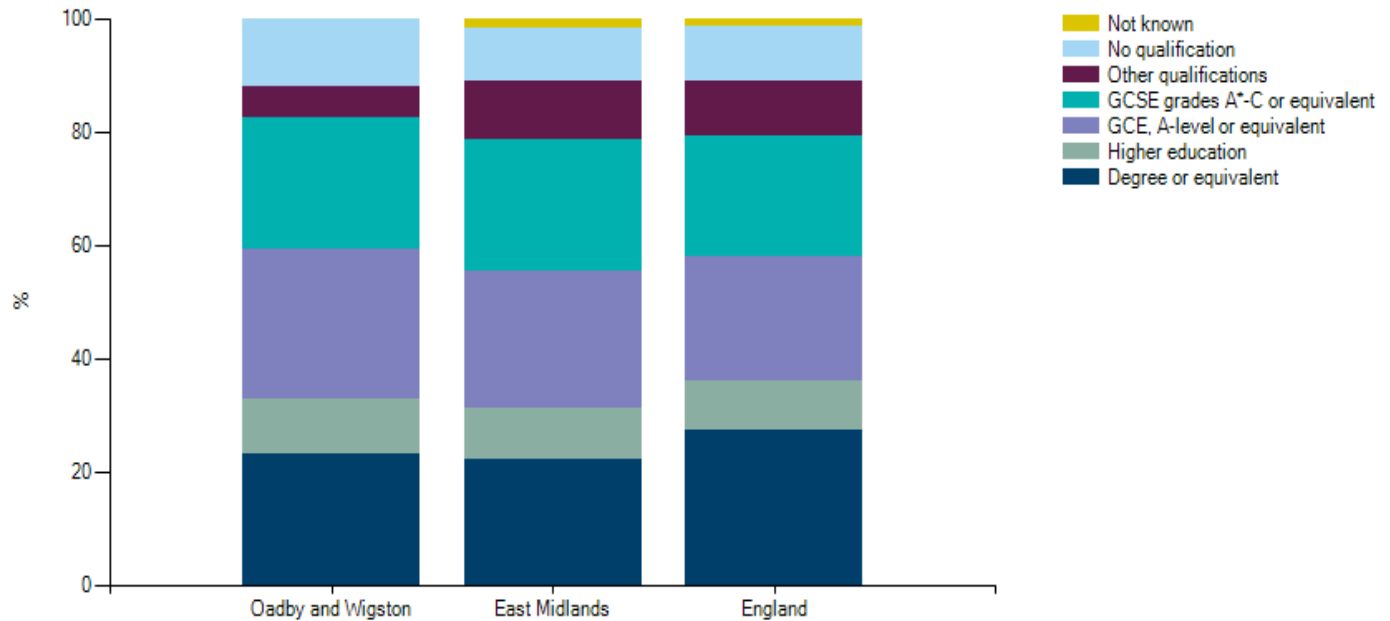

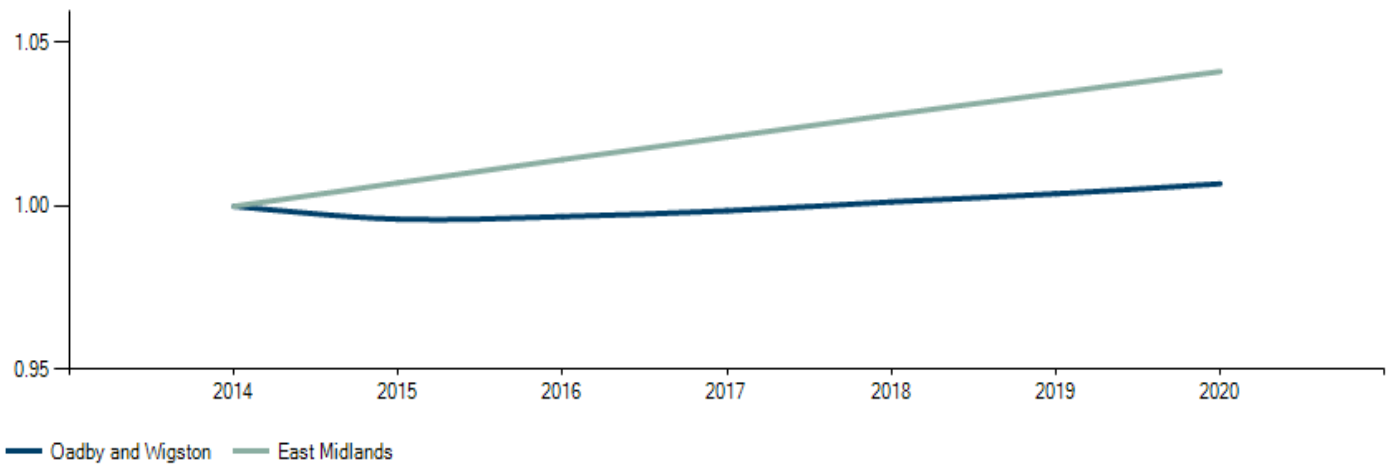

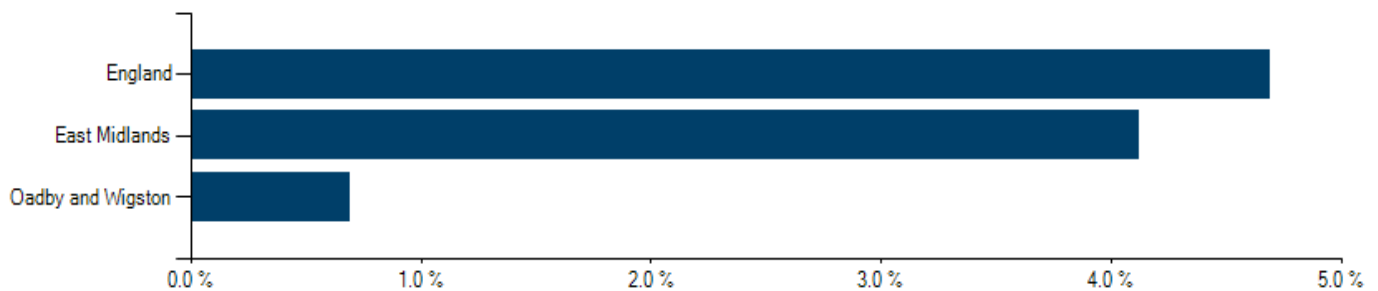
Indexed change in projected population (2014-2020)

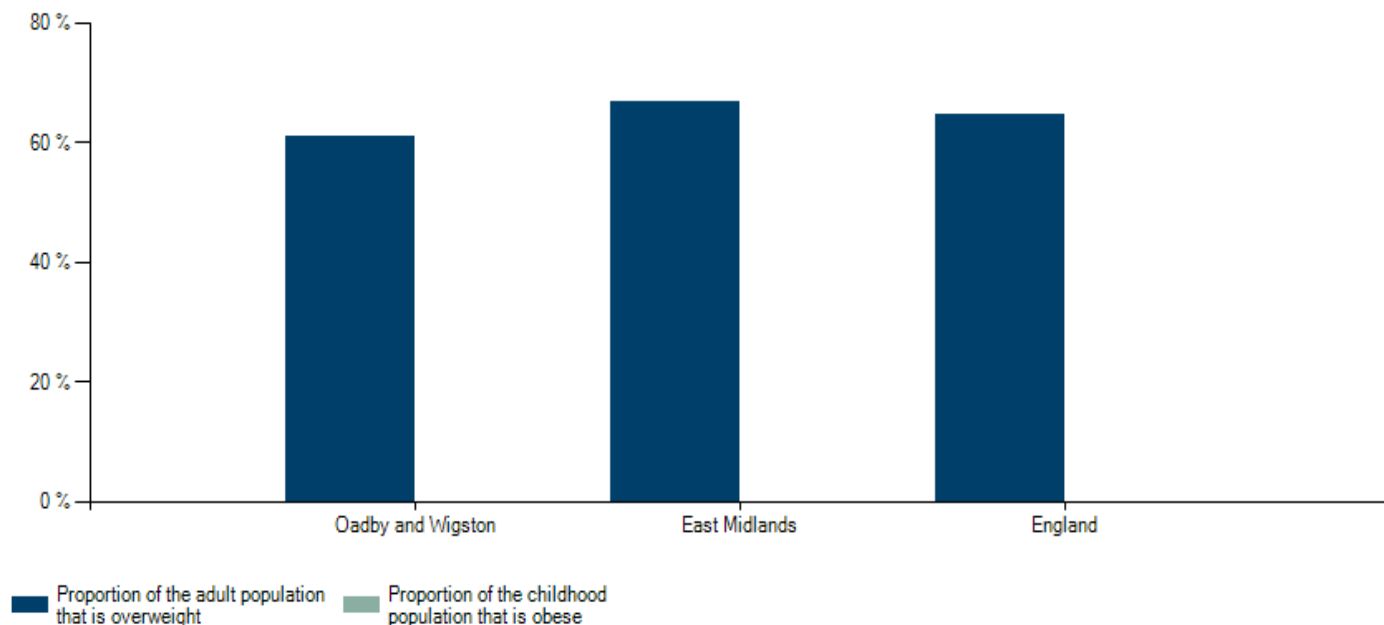

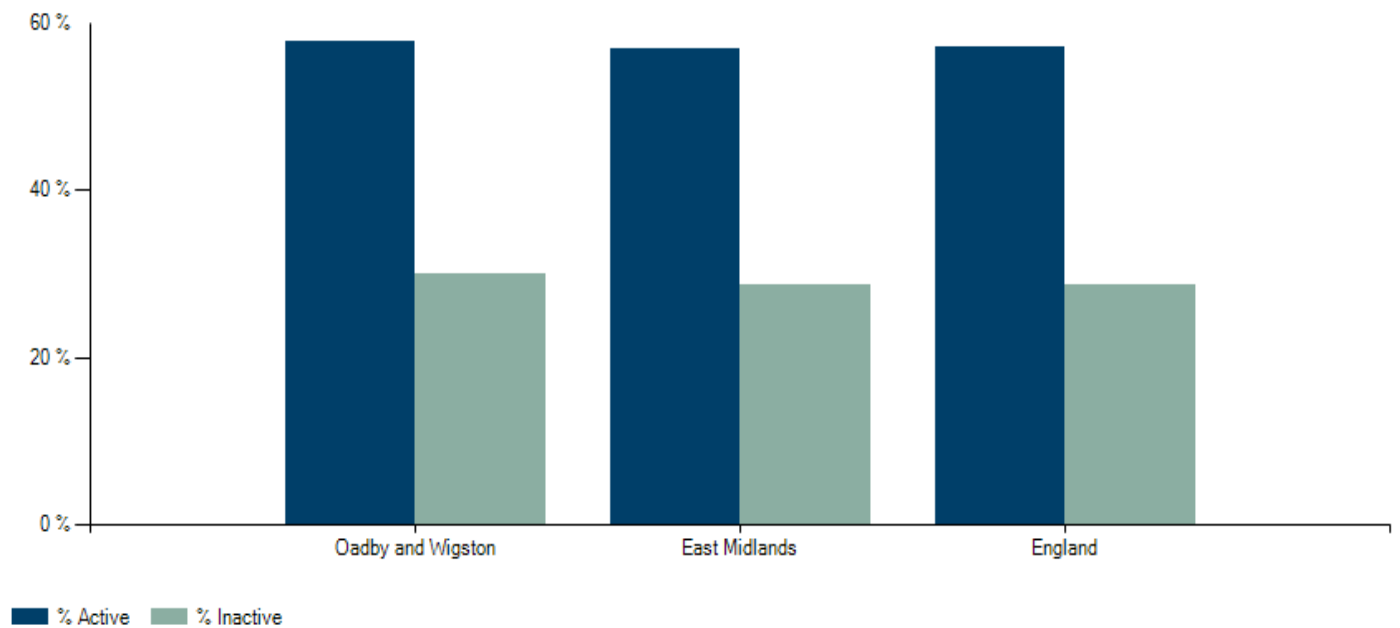

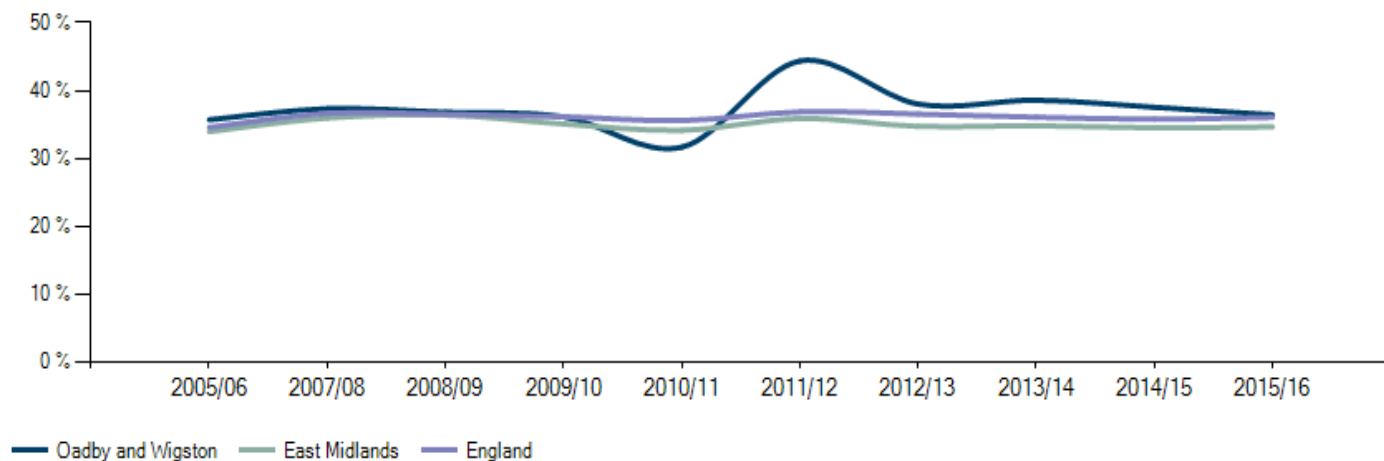

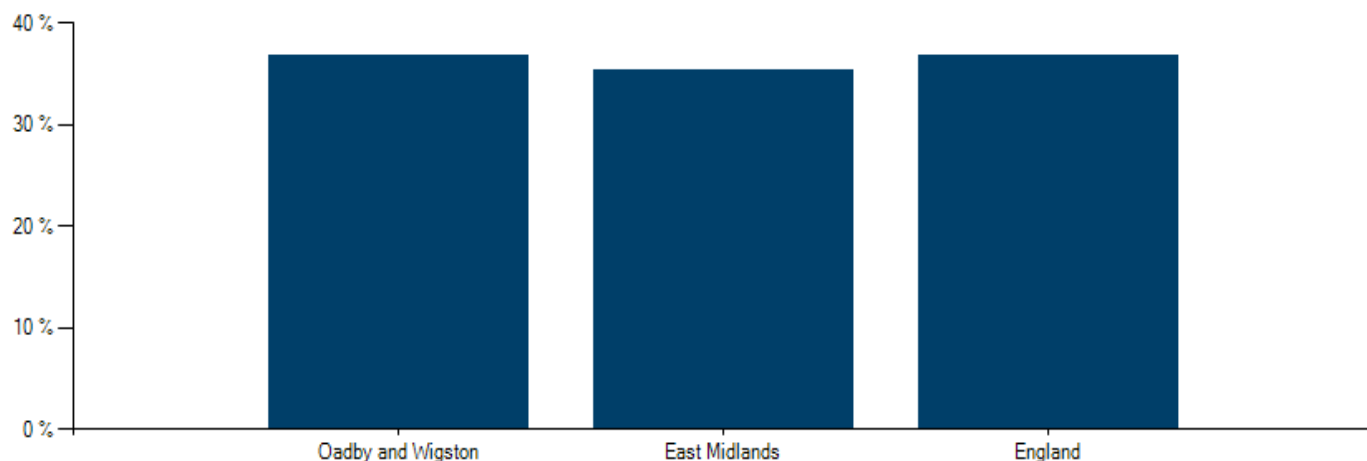

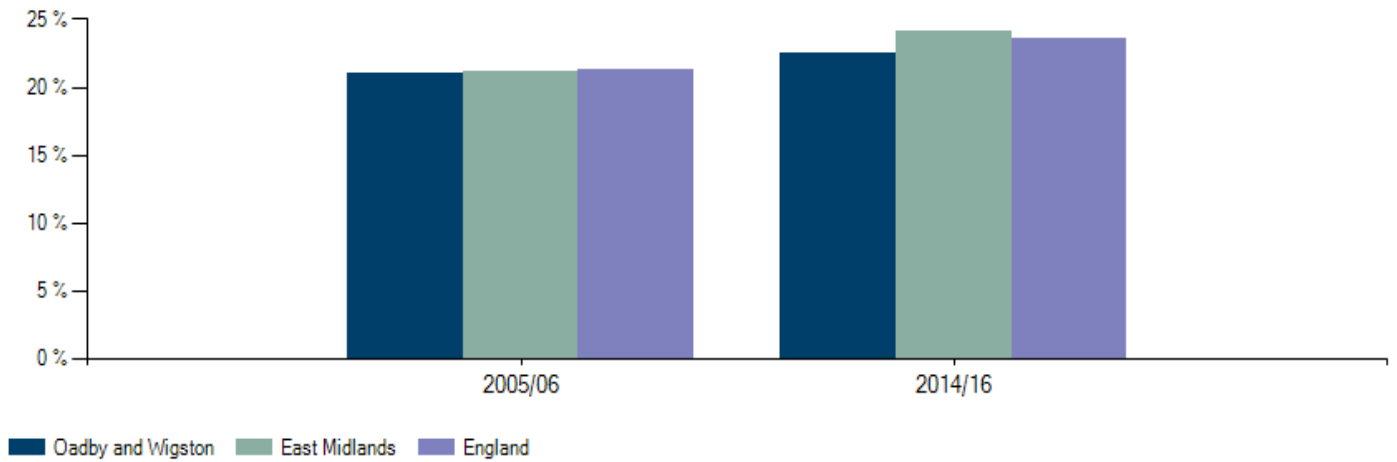

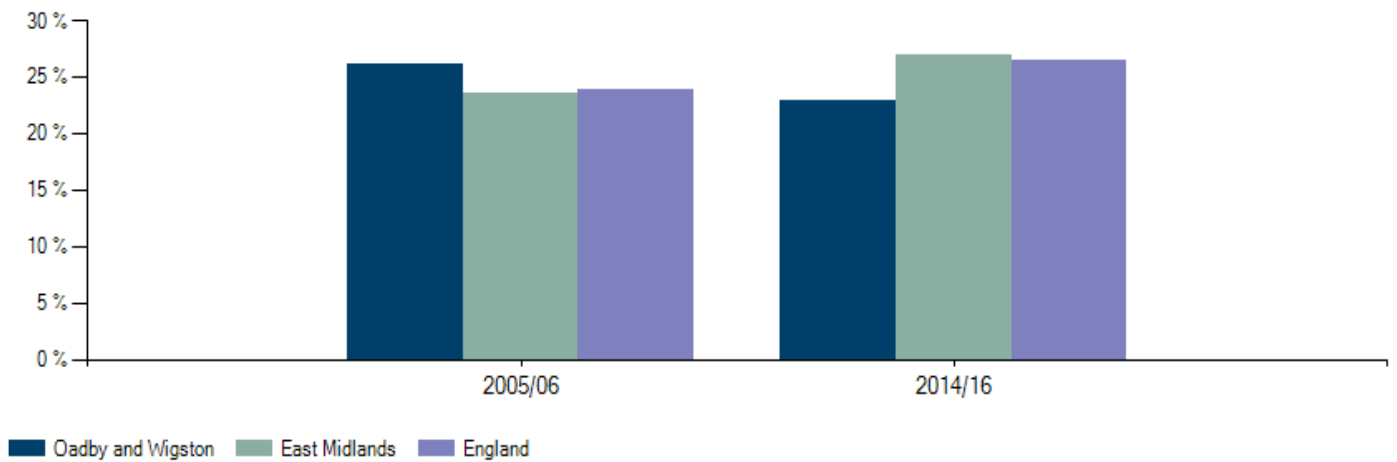
Total participation 3x30 (12 days plus)

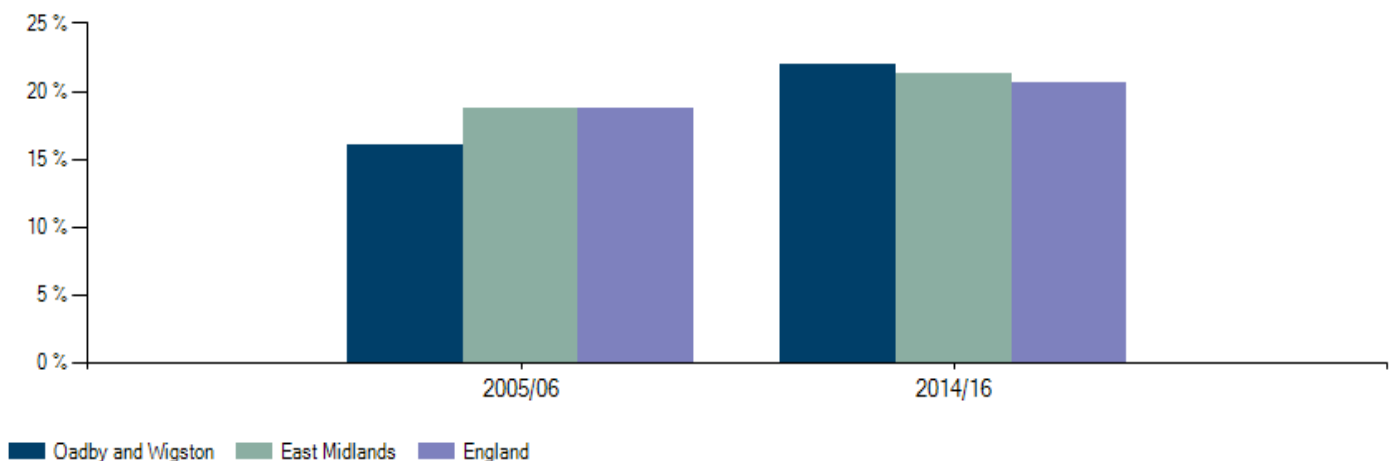
Male participation 3x30 (12 days plus)

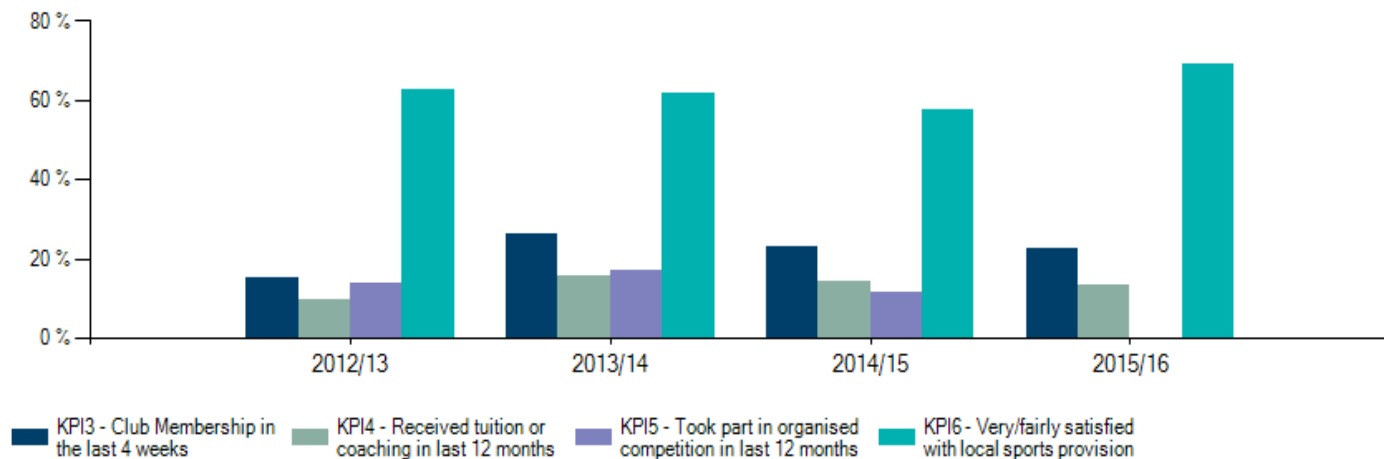

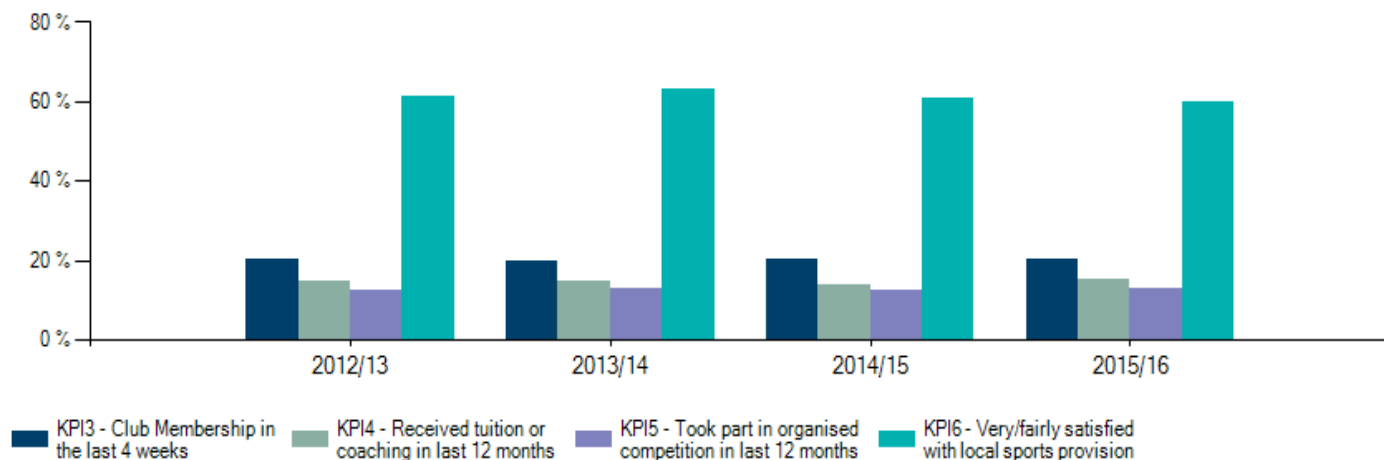

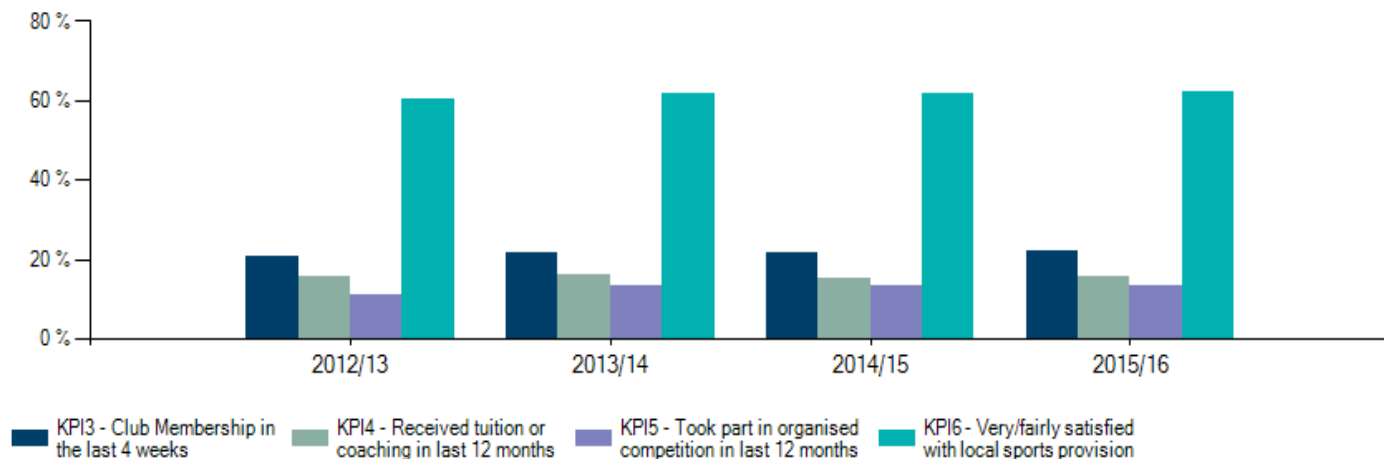
Understanding key performance indicators - Oadby and Wigston

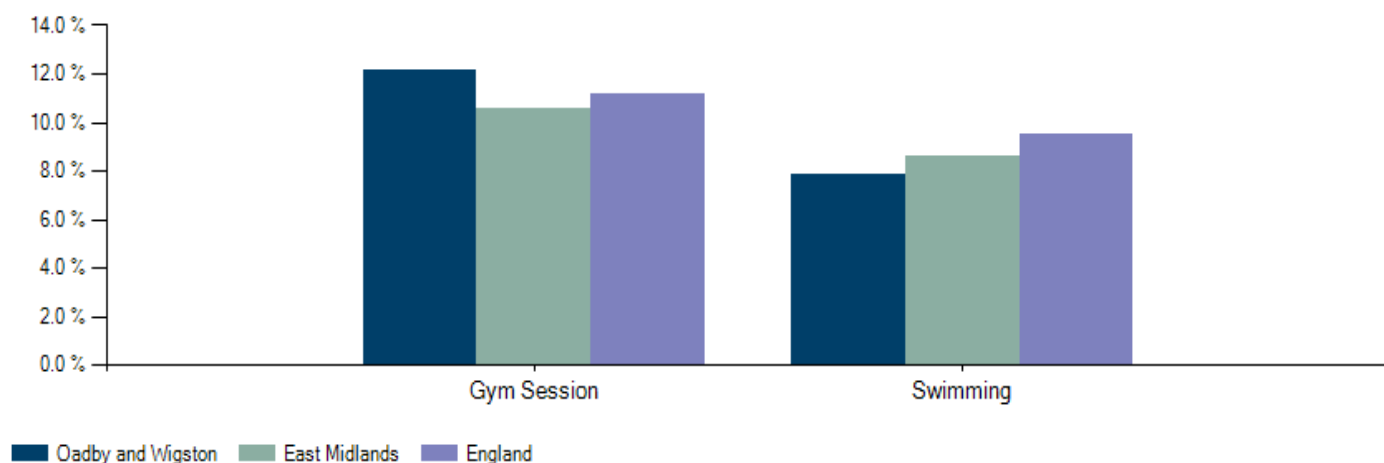

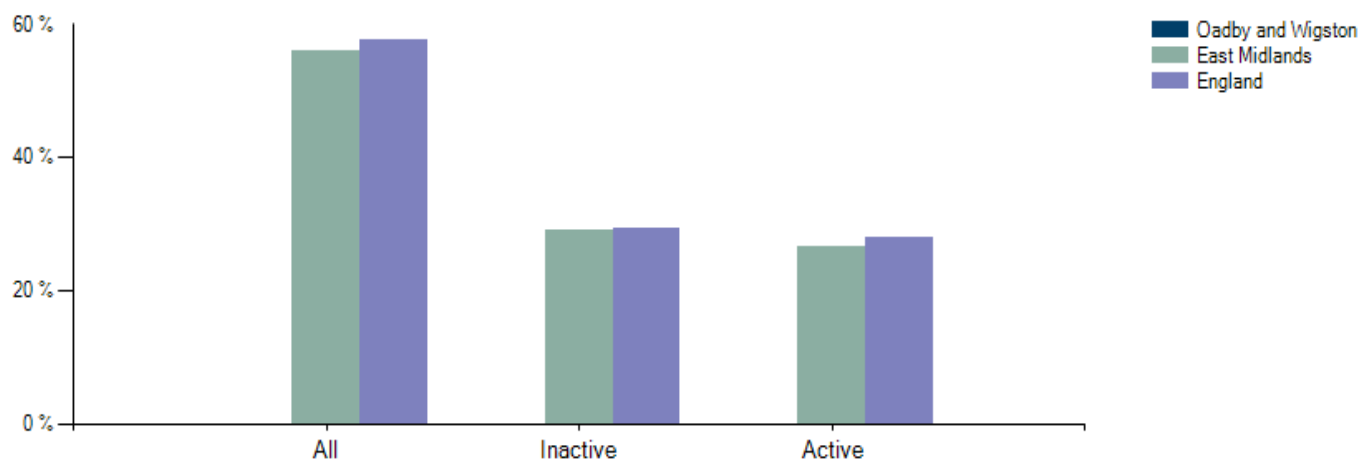

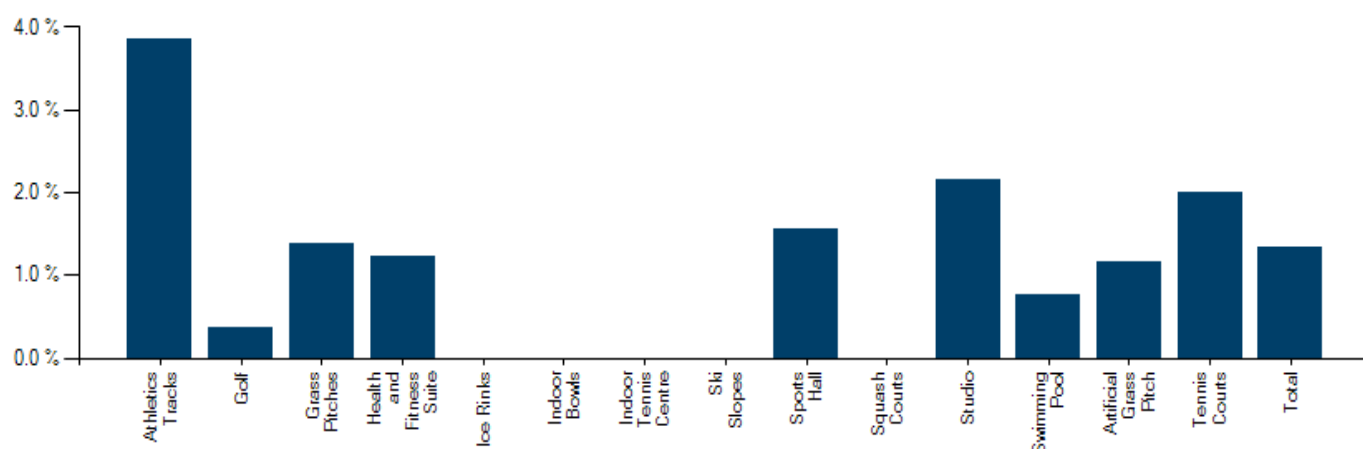

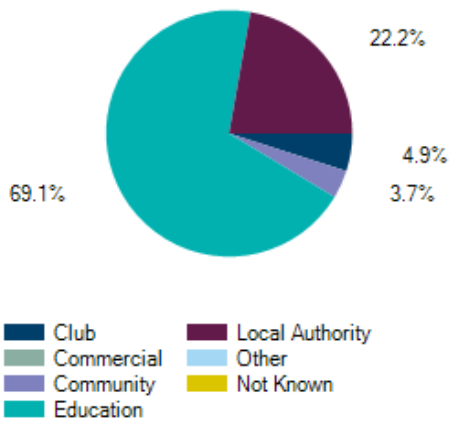

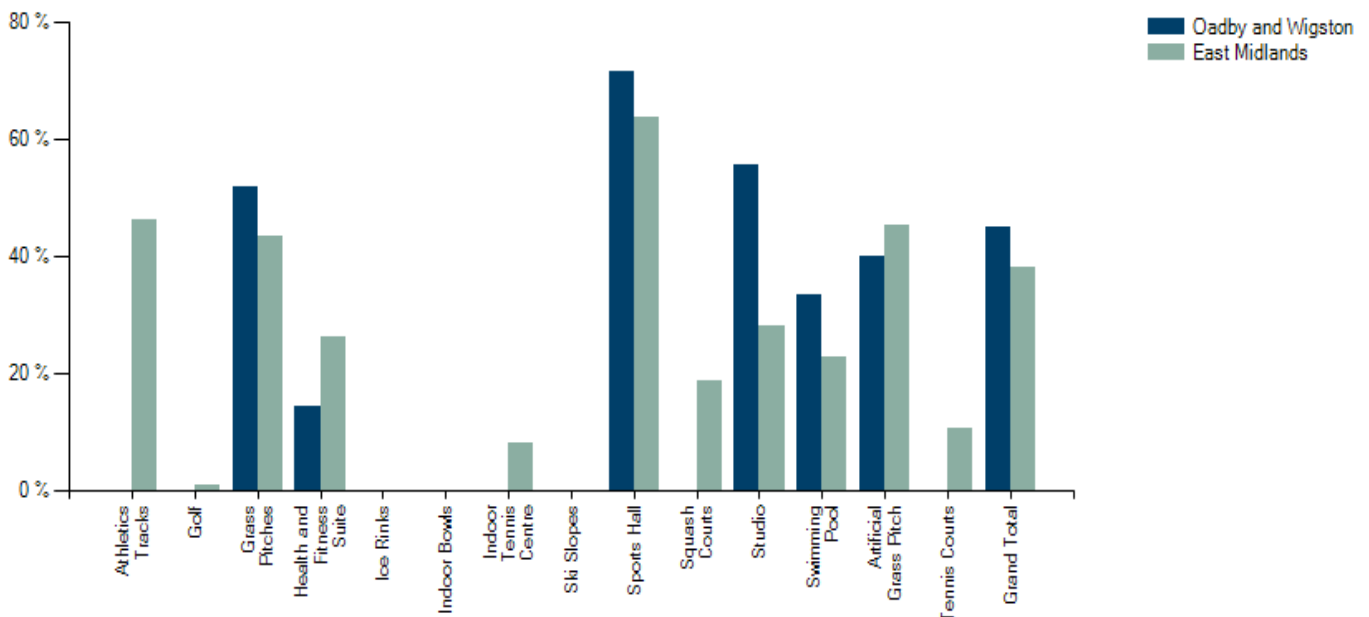

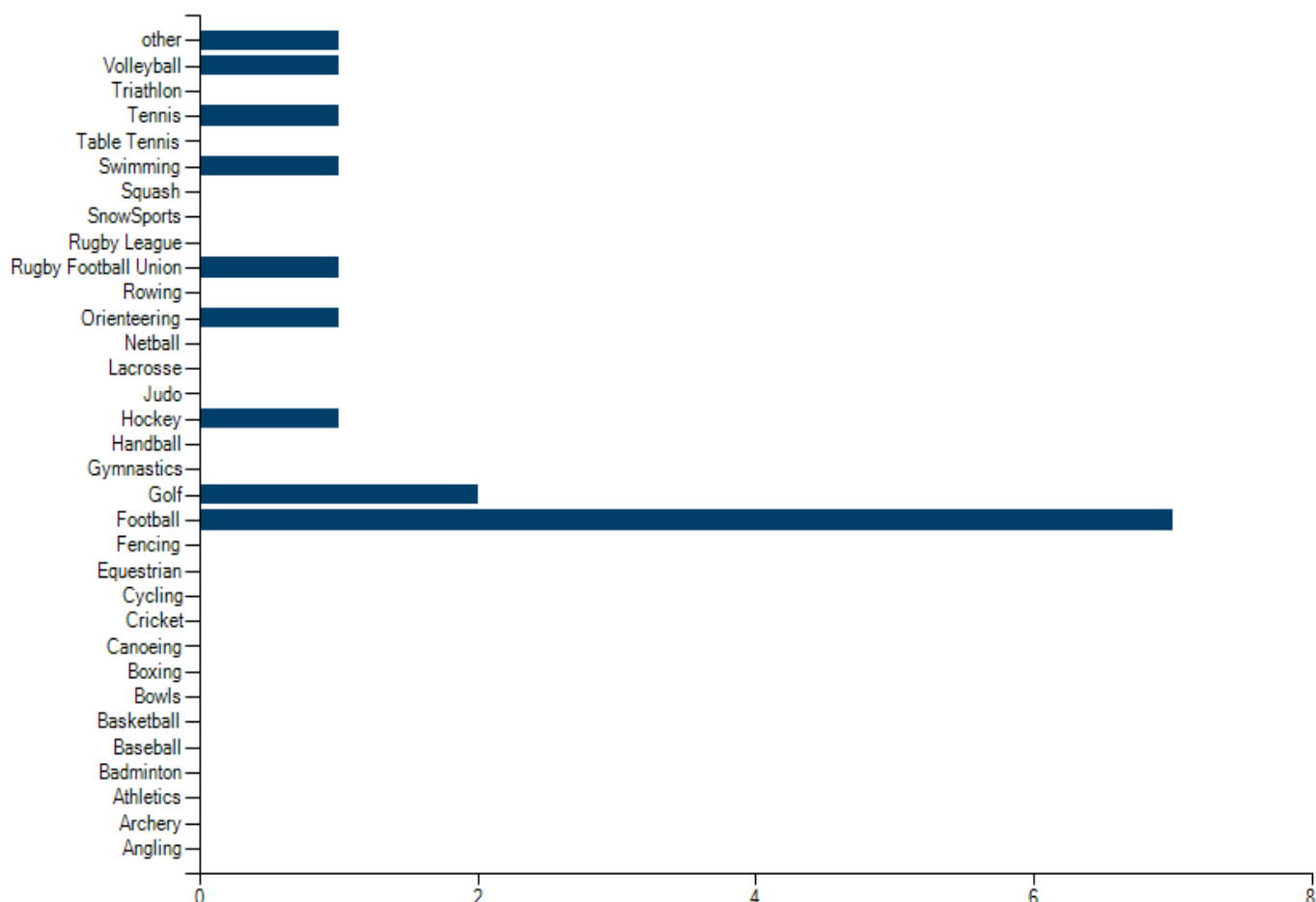

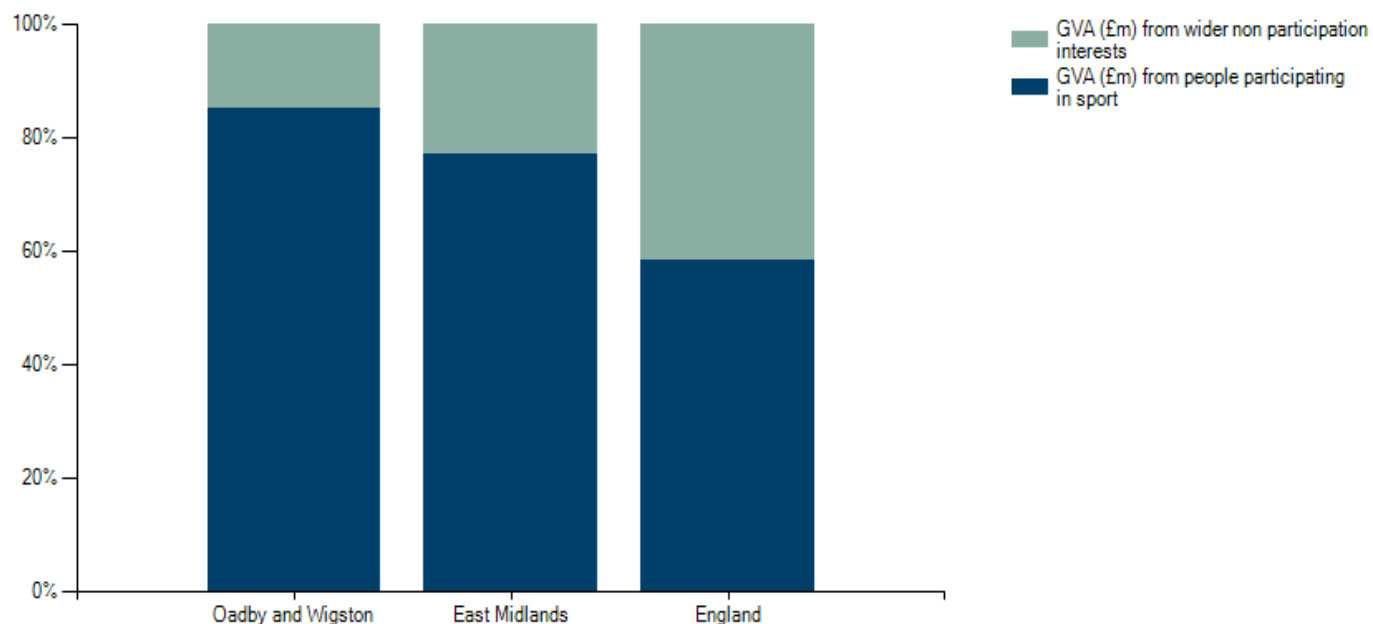

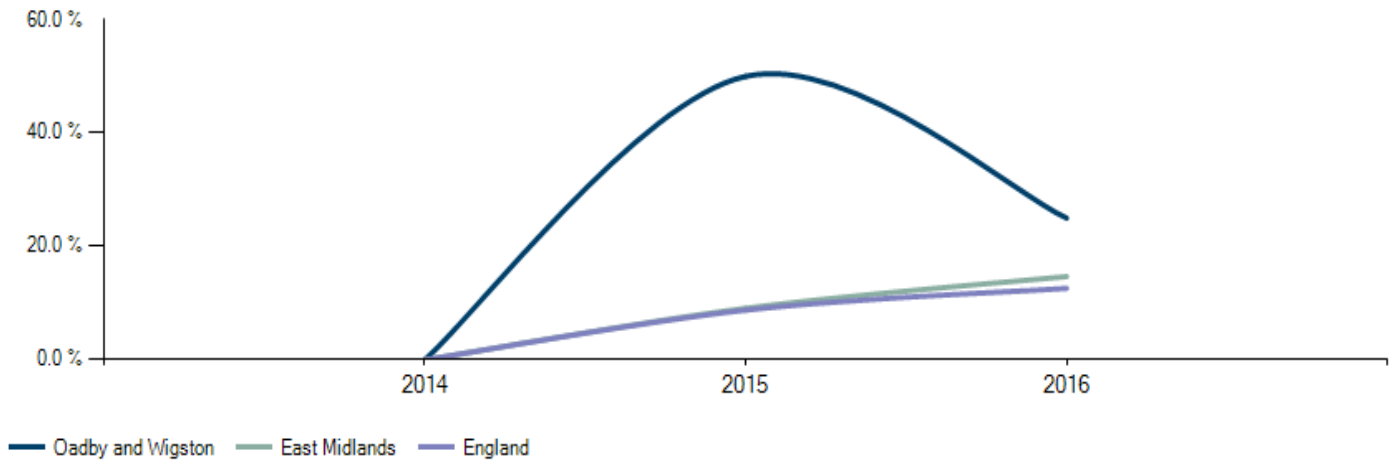

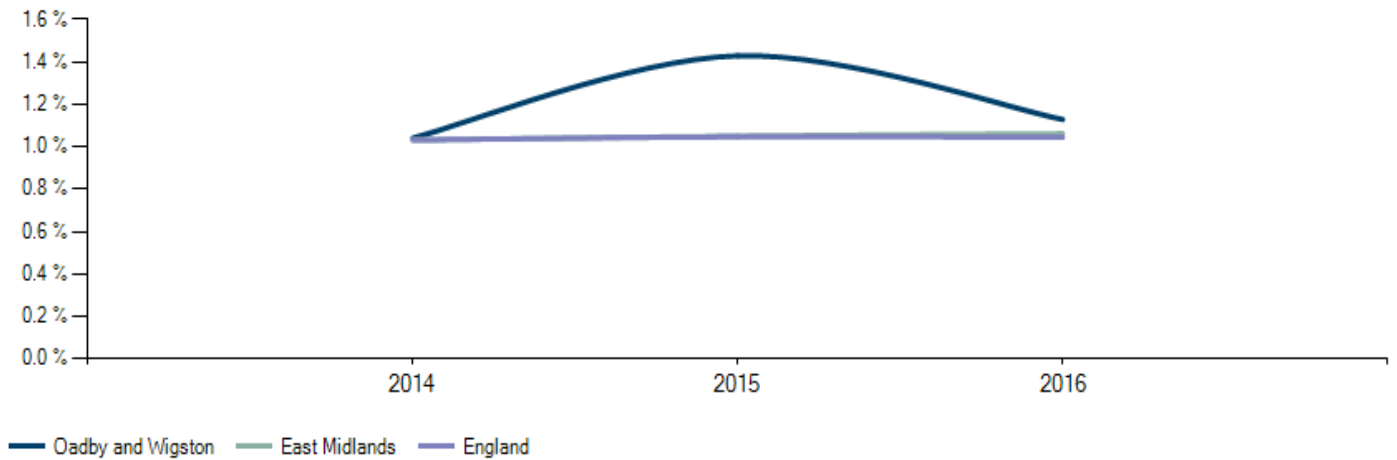

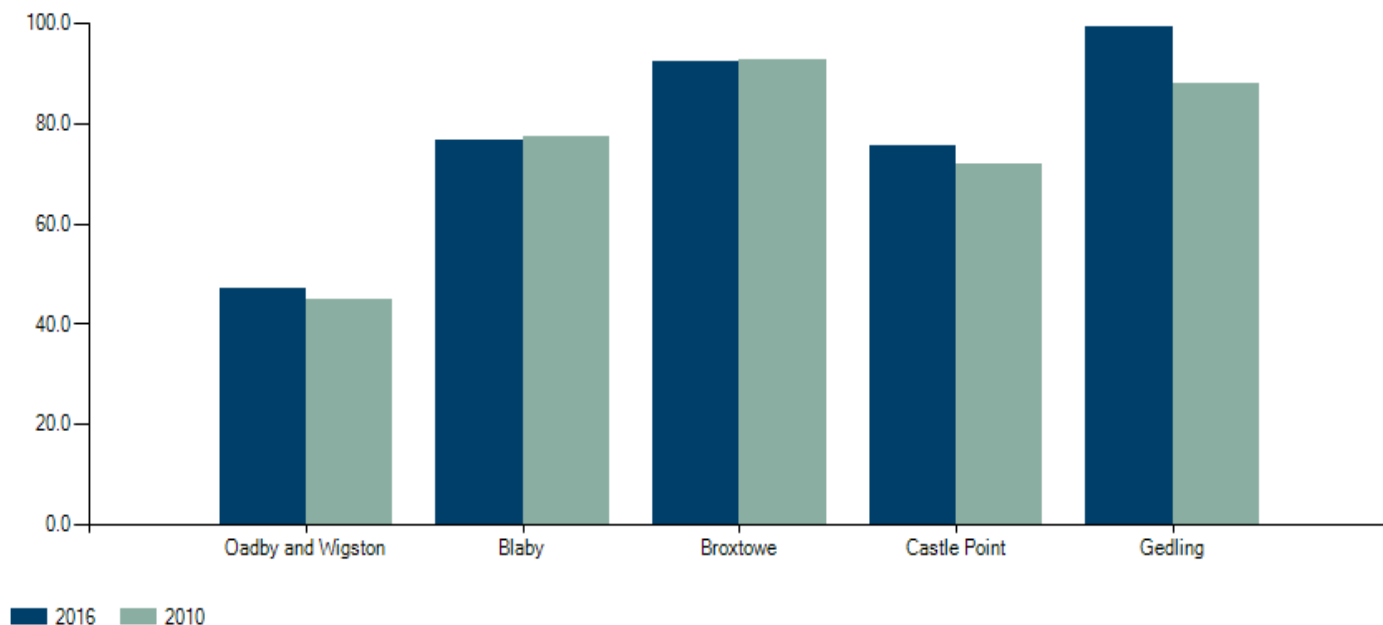

Nearest neighbour population comparison (000s)



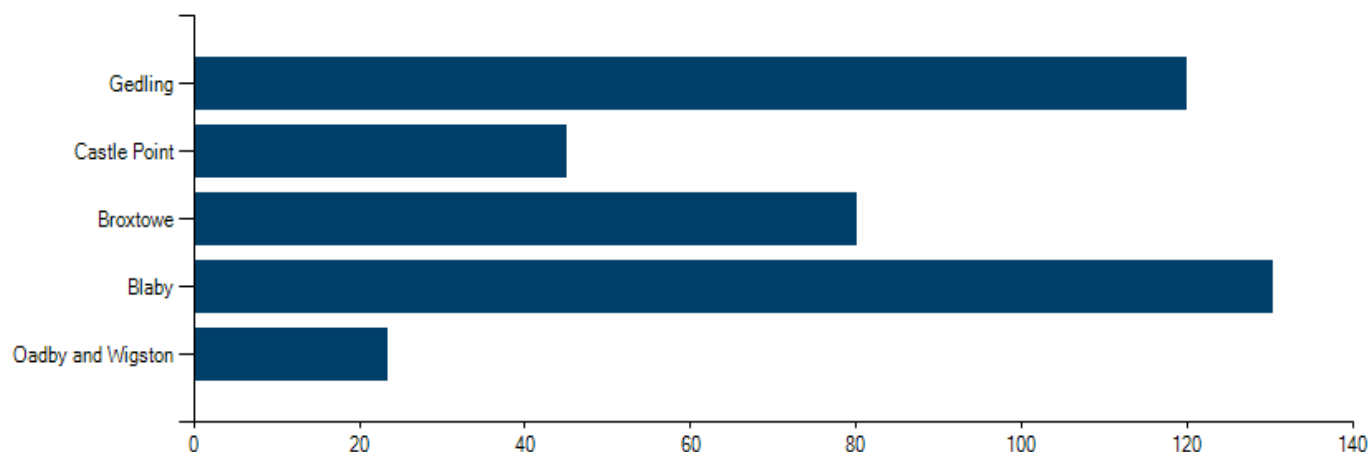

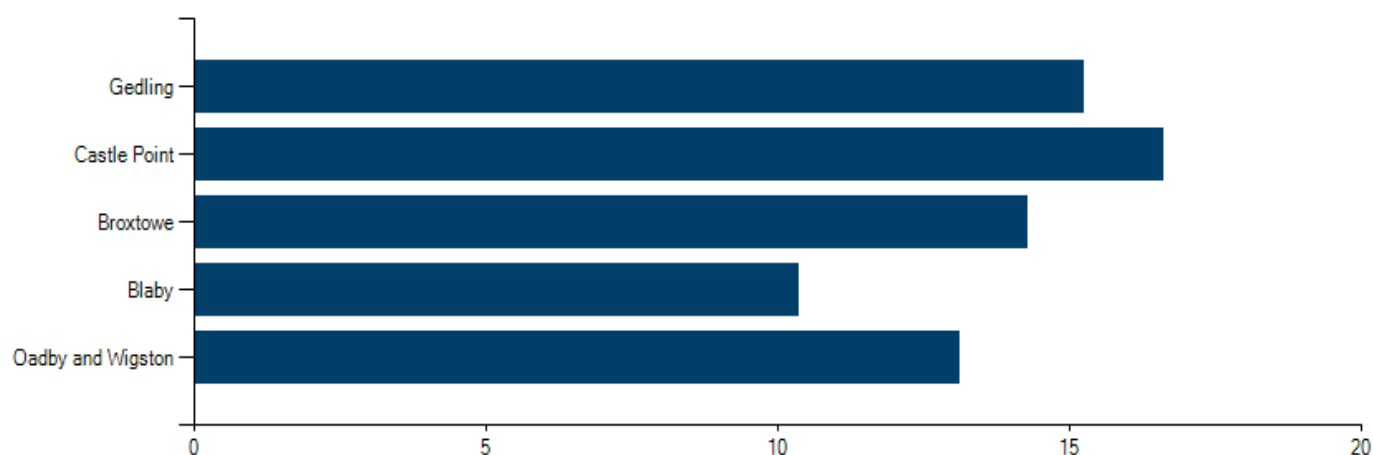

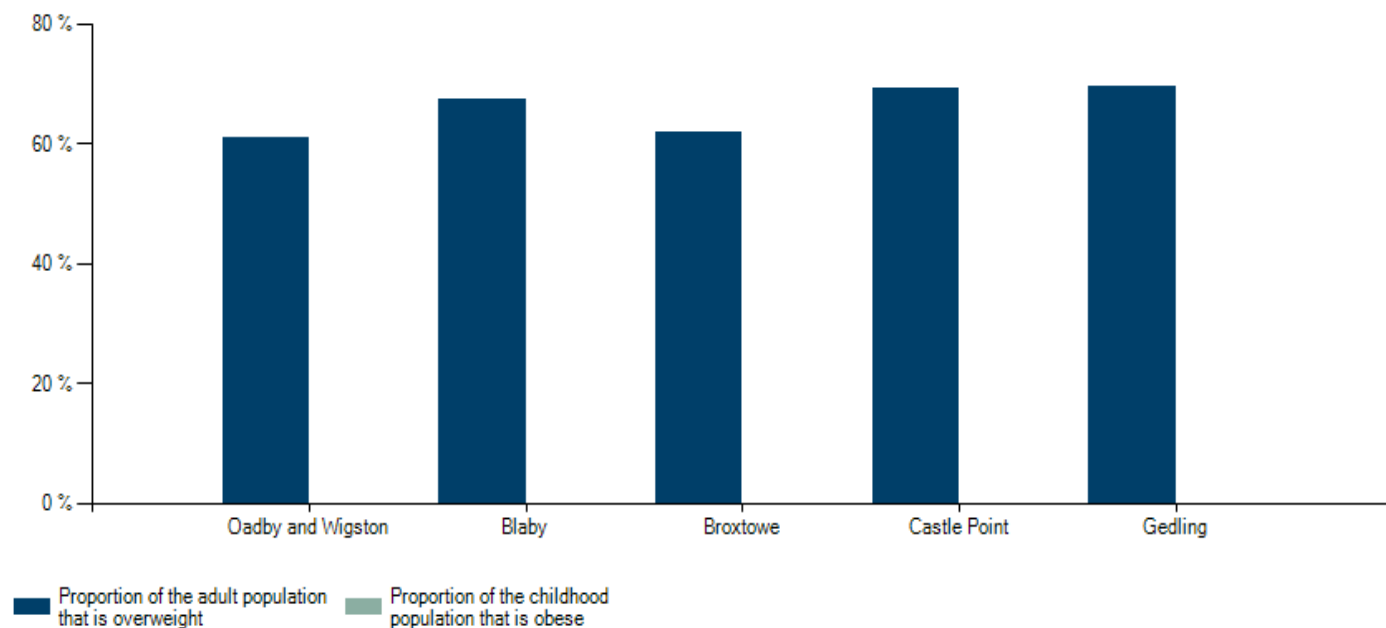

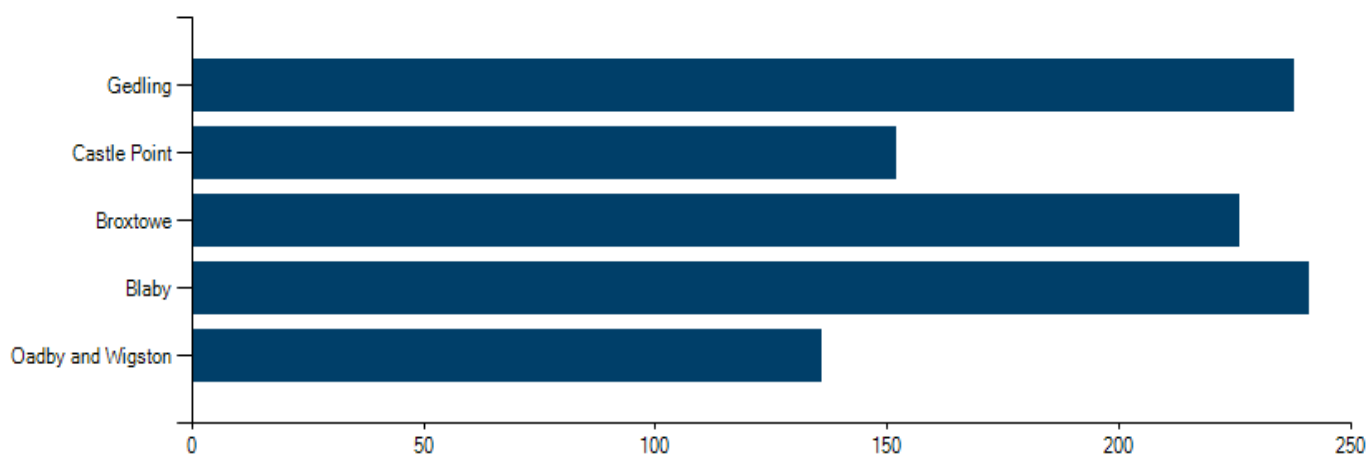
