The open register is an extract of the electoral register, but it is not used for elections. It can be bought by anyone and used for many purposes including confirming name and address details and direct marketing purposes.

Removing your details from the open register does not affect your right to vote.

You can find out more information about both registers and how they may be used at **gov.uk/register-to-vote** or you can contact us using the details on page 1.

PRIVACY STATEMENT We collect information under the legal basis of a task carried out in the public interest, as set out in the Representation of the People Act 1983 and related regulations. We look after personal information securely and follow data protection legislation. If you opted-out of the open register we will only use the information you give us for electoral purposes, including matching it against other sources of data to support the electoral register. If you are currently registered, where applicable, we have processed your data correctly. We will not give personal information to anyone else, unless we have to by law. The law requires us to share your information with candidates, political parties and campaigners for democratic engagement purposes and credit reference agencies to check your identity when you apply for credit. If you have <u>not</u> opted-out of the open register your name and address can be bought by anyone and used for lots of purposes, including direct marketing. The Electoral Registration Officer is the Controller. They must have a policy document known as a privacy notice setting out how they process personal data.
