Our canvassers may shortly be calling you or knocking on your door if you do not act now so we can confirm who is eligible to register to vote at your address!

Dear Electoral Services

We have still not received a response to our initial or reminder letters requesting you, or another member of your household, to confirm the information we hold on the electoral register for your address at:

Brocks Hill Council Offices
Washbrook Lane
Oadby
LE2 5JJ

You are legally required to take action so we can confirm who is eligible to register to vote, even if there are no changes to report.

You must respond either online (see the instructions below) or by text, telephone or post as instructed in our previous letters.

If you do not respond, you risk being fined up to £1,000!

Ring-ring... Knock-knock...

If you do not respond soon, a canvasser may call you or visit your address to get a response from you, or another household member, over the telephone or on the doorstep.

When visiting in person, canvassers will have an official council ID card which they will show you. They will not need to come into your home.

Respond now online in 3 quick and easy steps

1. Visit the website below by following the link.

2. Enter your unique security codes below and postcode

3. Update your household's information by following the on-screen instructions and submit. Include everyone's:
 - a. Full name(s)
 - b. Nationality
 - c. Contact information (optional)

If you add any new people at step 3, they will also need to complete a separate individual registration application.

They can [register to vote](#) online by following the link. We will send each person a paper form to complete if they do not apply online.

Voting by post or by proxy

If anyone living at the address wants to vote by post or proxy, they will also need to complete a separate absent vote application.

They can [apply to vote by post](#) or [by proxy](#) online by following the link(s). We will send them a paper form to complete if they do not apply online.
