

THE CLEAN AIR ACT 1956

THE OADBY NO. 1 SMOKE CONTROL ORDER, 1973

The Oadby Urban District Council in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956, hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Oadby No. 1 Smoke Control Order, 1973.
2. The area which is coloured green on the map prepared in duplicate, sealed with the common seal of the said Council and marked "Map referred to in the Oadby No. 1 Smoke Control Order, 1973" is hereby declared to be a smoke control area. One duplicate of the map is deposited in the offices of the said Council and the other is deposited in the offices of the Secretary of State for the Environment.
3. *Classes of fireplaces and the* The fireplaces in the area which are specified in the Schedule hereto shall be exempted from the operation of the said section 11 upon the conditions specified in respect thereof in the said Schedule.
4. This Order shall come into operation on 1st October, 1974.

SCHEDULE

CLASSES OF FIREPLACES

Description	Conditions
Fireplaces in buildings or parts of buildings separately occupied without gas supply <i>and those premises where the provision of ignition is unduly expensive.</i> <i>would be</i>	Only authorised fuels, as declared by regulations under the Clean Air Act, 1956, and kindling sticks and paper shall be used in fireplaces. <i>the</i>
Refuse Incinerator, situated at the Oadby U.D.C. Refuse Disposal Plant, <i>Wigston Road, Oadby</i>	<i>FIREPLACES</i> The fireplace shall be installed, maintained and operated so as to minimise the emission of smoke and in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions as to operation
Riley underfeed stoker to sectional hot water boiler at Langmoor Junior School, Kenilworth Drive, Oadby.	<i>The fireplace shall be</i> (1) Fitted with (a) Overfire Air Supply supplied from a separate fan, with preset overrun after Stoker stops, or (b) High/Low Control with overfire air supply and preset overrun after Stoker stops, or (c) Fully Modulating Automatic Control with overfire air supply and preset overrun after Stoker stops. All with preset supply of primary air before Stoker starts <i>and</i>
	(2) The fireplace shall be installed, maintained and operated so as to minimise the emission of smoke and in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions as to operation; and
	(3) No fuel shall be used other than that for which the stoker was designed
