

ALCOHOL BAN

THE OADBY AND WIGSTON BOROUGH COUNCIL **(PROHIBITION OF ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION** **IN DESIGNATED PUBLIC PLACES) ORDER 2002**

1. From 25th January 2002, the following places in South Wigston are designated as an area within the meaning of the provisions of section 13 of the Criminal Justice and Police Act 2001
 - i) Kenilworth Road between the footbridge over the railway lines (leading to Kirkdale Road and its junction with Marstown Avenue.
 - ii) The aforesaid bridge over the railway lines and the public footway joining the Footbridge to the junction with Kirkdale Road.
 - iii) Kirkdale Road between its junctions with Leopold Street and Albion Street.
 - iv) Station Street and the public car park on the east side of Station Street.
 - v) Blaby Road between its junctions with Saffron Road and Lansdowne Grove.
 - vi) Canal Street between its junction with Blaby Road and its junction with Countesthorpe Road.
 - vii) Countesthorpe Road between its junctions with Canal Street and Lansdowne Grove; and Countesthorpe Road so far South as the Borough Boundary at Crow Mills.
 - viii) The whole of the Public Picnic Site between the River Sence and the Grand Union Canal to the west of Countesthorpe Road.
 - ix) The towpath and the public footpath on the South side of the Grand Union Canal for 500 meters east and 500 meters west of the Countesthorpe Road public carriageway bridge over the Grand Union Canal.
 - x) The whole of the public land known as Blaby Road Park.
2. This Order will enable the Police to require any persons not to drink, or open alcohol containers in their possession, in the above areas and to surrender any alcohol Failure to comply with the Police officer's requirements in this respect, without reasonable excuse, is an arrestable offence.
