**Title of Document:**

**Subject Matter and Area Covered:**

Oadby and Wigston Borough Council has published its Draft Town Centres Area Action Plan Development Plan Document for a 6 week Public Consultation. The Publication Draft Town Centres Area Action Plan is one of the principle planning documents of the Oadby and Wigston Local Development Framework, which is a collection of documents that form part of the Development Plan covering the Borough.

The Publication Draft Town Centres Area Action plan sets out future development in the town centres of Wigston and Oadby up to 2026. It is in conformity with the Borough Council's Core Strategy vision and spatial objectives, and contains town centre specific policies and site allocations.

**Period Within Which Representations Must be Made:**

The statutory period for making representations in relation to the 'legal compliance' and 'soundness' of the Publication Draft Town Centres Area Action Plan Development Plan Document is for a period of 6 weeks starting on Friday 28 October 2011. **Representations must be submitted no later than 4.15pm on Friday 9 December 2011.**
